Theme: Loop Trail Extremes The Clues

1. Polaris will lead you to this point on the Loop Trail.
2. This point is a two-fer. Lowest and southern-most on the Loop Trail.
3. Stop here to pick up a map and tune-up your bike on the oldest part of the Loop Trail.
4. Bring your oxygen before you embark to the Everest of the Loop Trail.
5. In the wild west, possession is only 3/4 of the law!
6. At 326 feet, this structure is the longest of its type on the Loop Trail.
7. Don't blink, or you will miss this tiny trestle.
8. Slip on under one of Fairfield's busiest streets.
9. Catch a cool breeze off the largest lake on the Loop from this resting point.
10. The time capsule in Central Park will be opened this year _____.

The Scavenger Hunt opens May 26, 2018 at sunrise, and closes on July 6, 2018 at 7:00 PM. One entry per person. Pick up punch cards at AJ's Bike Shop (123 North Court Street), trailhead kiosks, Fairfield Rec Center, MUM Rec Center, or www.jeffersoncountyrails.org. There are two types of clue locations: 1. Checkpoint clue locations are an orange punch with CP number sticker. Punches are zip-tied to a structure. Check points are in the trail corridor or easily accessible. Bushwhacking is not required, or allowed. 2. Landmark clue locations are a particular landmark along the trail. Participants will fill in the blank on the punch card with the answer related to the landmark in the clue. Participants that find all 10 clues will be entered in drawings for prizes. Submit completed punch cards anytime to AJ's Bike Shop; Jefferson County Trails Council, P.O. Box 2375, Fairfield, IA 52556; or to Central Park during Art Walk on July 6 only.
