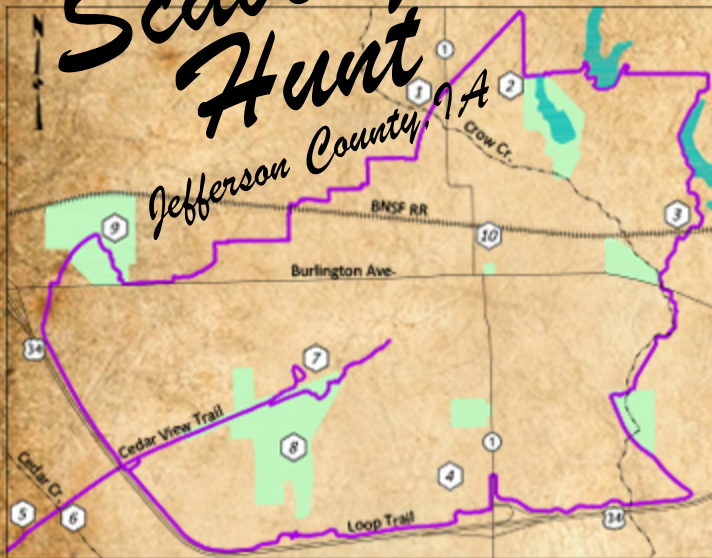

The Rules

The Scavenger Hunt opens May 25, 2019 at sunrise, and closes on July 5, 2019 at 7:00 PM. One entry per person. Pick up punch cards at AJ's Bike Shop (123 North Court Street), trailhead kiosks, Fairfield Rec Center, MUM Rec Center, or www.jeffersoncountytrails.org. There are two types of clue locations: 1. Checkpoint clue locations are an orange punch with CP number sticker. Punches are zip-tied to a structure. Check points are in the trail corridor or easily accessible. Bushwhacking is not required, or allowed. 2. Landmark clue locations are a particular landmark along the trail. Participants will fill in the blank on the punch card with the answer related to the landmark in the clue. Participants that find all 10 clues will be entered in drawings for prizes. Submit completed punch cards anytime to AJ's Bike Shop; Jefferson County Trails Council, P.O. Box 2375, Fairfield, IA 52556; or to Central Park during Art Walk on July 5 only. The drawing will take place during Art Walk on July 5, 2019. Need not be present to win. To report missing or damaged checkpoints, call Steve at 641-919-5565.
