The Scavenger Hunt opens April 25, 2026 at sunrise and closes on July 3, 2026 at 7:00 PM. One entry per person. Pick up punch cards at The Ride: Bike Sales and Service (123 North Court Street), trailhead kiosks, Fairfield Rec Center, MUM Rec Center, or www.jeffersoncountytrails.org.

Orange hole punches with a CP number sticker are located in the trail corridor or public park areas. The location of the orange hole punch corresponds with the written clue and location shown on map. Participants that find all 10 punches will be entered in drawings for prizes. Submit completed punch cards to The Ride: Bike Sales and Service (through 5:00PM on July 3), the JCTC booth at Fairfield First Fridays (6:00-7:00PM July 3), or to: Jefferson County Trails Council, P.O. Box 2375, Fairfield, IA 52556.

The drawing for prizes will take place during Fairfield First Fridays on July 3, 2026. Need not be present to win. To report missing or damaged check point punches, call Steve at 641-919-5565.
