Subject: Fall Trail Drive Through

Bring your binoculars and cameras to the Jefferson County Trails system for the Fall Trail Drive Through. The Jefferson County Conservation Board and Jefferson County Trails Council are hosting this event on Sunday, October 18 from 11:30 AM to 2:30 PM.

The trail system will be open for vehicles to drive through in three locations.

Route 1: Enter Cedar View trail off 32nd Street and exit at 223rd Street 1.5 miles later.

Route 2: Enter Cedar View trail off 32nd Street and drive the Fairfield Loop Trail east to the Maasdam Barns.

Route 3: Enter Fairfield Loop Trail near Chautauqua Park at the Parkview Care Center Driveway and drive north to Pleasant Plain Road.

Participants will enjoy the fall colors and experience local wildlife. "This project is a great opportunity for people of all ages to enjoy the trail system", says Trails Council Chairman Stephen Pedrick.

"The Trails Council is managing Route 3, while the Conservation Board is managing Routes 1 and 2." Pedrick adds. Sites of the Chautauqua to Pleasant Plain Road route include: community orchard, wetlands, Louden Bridge over the BNSF railroad, and Walton Lake.
